



The Weather

As with all of the activity sheets discuss the pictures, language and communication are key. Ask questions such as:

What is the weather like today?

What can we do when the weather is like this?

What clothes are good for this weather?

What weather do you like? Why?

What weather do you not like?

Discuss the different types of weather on the vocab card.

Before you begin decorating the weather posters discuss the activity.

Ask your child:

How could we decorate it?

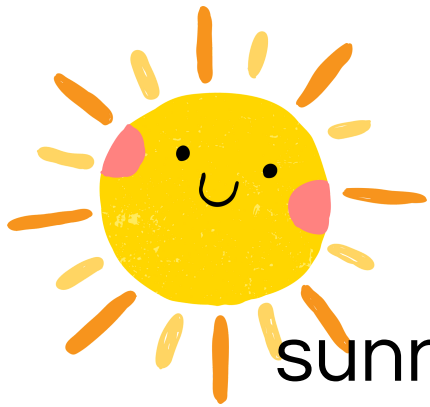
What do we have that we could use?

What colours can we use?

- Ask your child if they can follow the lines with their fingers.
- You can also place the sheets in a poly pocket and use a non permanent marker to trace the lines to practice before using a mark making tool.
- Using pens, pencils, crayons or paint follow the lines or colour the pictures.
- Using paper, tissue, stickers, newspaper or play dough balls follow the lines.
- Glue pasta, wool, pipe cleaners, buttons or pom poms onto the lines.
- Create a mosaic using different colored paper.
- You can also use these pictures to practice using scissors.
- Ultimately, its all about getting little fingers moving and developing hand eye co-ordination.
